 - **Equity Team** – What it is and purpose/ Review of Student Success Survey **We reviewed what the equity team is, why we implemented it and the pieces or the student Success Survey that show the positive work we are doing and the areas we need to address further (Homophobia/transphobia/Discrimination/Racism). We had good discussion about how education and teaching student the importance of safety and a safe learning environment are what govern the provincial code of conduct (human rights). Hoping for parent feedback in the next survey coming in spring 2023.**
 - **Food security issues/Breakfast snack program** – long term planning/ Support from Lisa Roberts (Nourish NS) **Kim shared connection with Nourish (Lisa Roberts) and how she can help HRCE – Oxford and Joe Howe expand programming for snack/breakfast programs. Lisa is working with Kelly Sherwood.**
Christina is leading breakfast program/Snack program with staff and students engaged in support the program. We have seen lots utilizing the program and an improvement in waste reduction and students staying in class and engaging.
